TUITION

To reserve a place in any class, a deposit of an amount equal to the first monthly installment (plus \$30 registration fee if new student) is required. A semester deposit is due at registration. The annual tuition savings discount applies to tuition paid in full by September 13. Installment payments are due on the 15th of the month and are payable through Auto-pay only. If annual or semester tuition is not paid within 15 days from the beginning of each semester, a late fee of \$25 will be applied.

CLASS LEVELS

Elementary level placement is determined by the student's age on September 1 with no exceptions. Intermediate, Advanced Placement and Company levels are determined by faculty recommendations. Space in some levels is at a premium. Class enrollment will be closed when a predetermined number for each level is reached. Waiting lists are available. Class schedule is subject to change.

Withdrawal

If a student withdraws from class for any reason, notice should be given to the office as soon as possible.

Tuition Refunds/Credits

Registration fees and tuition are nonrefundable except for medical reason with doctor's written explanation or due to relocation.

Make Up Class

No credit or refund is provided for missed classes. If student misses class due to illness or other unavoidable reason, class may be made up at any time within the same semester.

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance based upon need and merit is available through the School of Canton Ballet financial assistance program, which includes the Kerri L. Hunter Memorial Minority Scholarship. Applications must be completed and returned by August 15, 2011. Applications are available in the office and online at cantonballet.com.

The Nutcracker Performances

Students from Creative Movement 2 and up may be selected to appear in *The Nutcracker*. Selection is based upon student's attendance and classroom behavior both during the current and previous semesters. Students who wish to appear will be required to attend the mandatory rehearsals and follow all performance rules. A participation fee (\$60 single/\$75 family) will be due by October 30.
