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New Teen & Adult Ballet Classes Offered

The School of Canton Ballet under Artistic Director Cassandra Crowley announces an expansion of its Teen & Adult Division beginning September with the opening of its fall semester classes.

A new beginner ballet class for teen and adults will be offered starting Monday, September 8, at 6:45 to 7:45 p.m. The instructor is Angelo Lemmo, longtime faculty member and choreographer in residence. Also on Mondays, the school will offer a new intermediate ballet class for teens and adults at 7 to 8:15 p.m. in addition to its current intermediate ballet class which meets on Wednesdays 6:45 to 8 p.m. Assistant to the Director Jennifer Catazaro Hayward will teach the new Monday intermediate class and Lemmo the new beginner ballet class. Lemmo will also continue to teach a teen and adult choreography class on Wednesdays 8-9 p.m.

Students may be just beginning or may be continuing their study of ballet. In the Teen & Adult area the emphasis is on enjoyment of movement, increasing flexibility and building an appreciation of dance.
