

# STAGE MAKE-UP

\*Begin with a clean face. Apply moisturizer; otherwise make-up will be difficult to remove.

\*All make-up and lines should sweep up and away from eye, never down.

1. Foundation - match skin tone; Apply to the face, blending into the hairline and below the chin line

2. Eye shadow - medium to dark brown eye shadow; Apply in arc and fill in

3. Eyeliner - black or dark brown and liquid works best; Apply to upper lid extending line outward and upward slightly beyond eye, but not beyond length of eyebrow. Lines must be VERY fine.

May add lower line parallel to first line beginning halfway under eye and ending same or shorter than top line and VERY thin. p

4. False Eyelashes- May need to be cut off at one end to fit more comfortably. Apply with small amount of eyelash glue to upper eye lash lid, press firmly. All dancers Intermediate and older are required to wear false eye lashes...even if the dancers own lashes are very, very long!!!!

5. Mascara- black or dark brown

6. Blush- pink; Smile and apply upwards towards temples

7. Lipstick- true red for older dancers (company) and pink for children
