

# HEALTHY TOGETHER AT CANTON BALLET'S *THE NUTCRACKER*

*Read on for our revised policy...*

We are eager to welcome you back for a safe and memorable experience at Canton Ballet's *The Nutcracker*. Our commitment to the health and safety of our guests, artists and performers, staff and volunteers is our first priority always.

**We have joined with performing arts venues in the Northeast Ohio region and around the country to implement a safer return to full-capacity live indoor performances by requiring masks to be worn in all areas of Canton Palace Theatre and for all audience members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.**

We understand the concerns you may have as you consider buying tickets to future events and we want you to feel confident in your purchase.

As your performance date approaches, if you or a member of your group are not feeling well or have concerns about attending a show, know that we have flexible options available for you.

Please contact us in advance of your show time and date and we will review your options with you.

## VACCINATION REQUIRED

All audience members 12 and up must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Children under 12 are exempted. **Masks are required for all aged 3 and up.**

- "Fully vaccinated" means that 14 days have passed since either the second shot of a CDC or WHO-approved two-shot vaccine or since the administration of a CDC or WHO-approved one-shot vaccine.
- Any audience member (ages 12 and up) who cannot be vaccinated will be required to provide proof of a negative test result received from a completed lab-certified antigen COVID-19 test within 24 hours prior to entering the theater or a negative test result received from a completed PCR COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to entering the theater. The BinaxNOW COVID-19 Home Test (the version requiring a virtual appointment) is an acceptable option. More information about COVID-19 testing is available on local or state Department of Health websites.
- Ticket holders must show proof of vaccination or negative test at their time of entry into the theater with a valid ticket. They may present proof of vaccination or negative test on paper or a smartphone.
- In addition to proof of vaccination or negative test result, all guests aged 12 and up must also present ID, such as a driver's license or passport. Guests under 18 may also use a school photo ID.

## **STAY HOME IF ILL**

Ticket holders who have been exposed to COVID-19 and/or are experiencing symptoms are asked to remain at home and contact Canton Ballet to discuss flexible options for their tickets.

## **MASKS REQUIRED**

Masks are required in all areas of Canton Palace Theatre. Everyone in the theater must wear acceptable face coverings at all times, including during the show, except while eating and drinking in designated locations. All face coverings must cover the nose and mouth and comply with CDC guidelines for acceptable face coverings.

## **BRINGING CHILDREN TO A SHOW**

Canton Ballet's mask requirements apply to ALL audience members 3 and above.

## **SEATING**

All engagements will be ticketed up to full capacity.

## **TICKETS**
